

Important Information

When you arrive at Saratoga Springs, you need to check in at the registration desk on the porch of the main lodge. At that time, you will complete a number of legal forms including a release and acknowledgement of the event. If you are OK with having photographs taken of you, you will need to sign a model release form.

After completing the check-in process, you will be issued a badge with your name, as specified in the registration system, your badge comment (if any) and your club affiliation (if any). If you are uncomfortable having your photograph taken, we will issue you a badge printed on brightly colored paper. Badges need to be worn at all times while at LLW, unless you are in the swimming pool, hot tub, or engaging in an activity where wearing the badge would be dangerous or impractical.

- Please bring your own towel, soap, shampoo, etc.
- If you have been confirmed for indoor lodging, only a bottom sheet is provided on your bed(s), so bring bedding with you.
- Bring a plastic or metal mug to use throughout the weekend for water and other beverages. Glass mugs are prohibited in the areas near the swimming pool.
- Bring a flashlight. It gets very dark at night. You don't want to trip over someone else's tent stakes or tie-downs.
- Please bring mosquito prevention products Off® with DEET works but if you can get it, Avon Skin So Soft works just as well and smells (and tastes) better. The resort will be sprayed but it's surrounded by heavy woods and the mosquitoes will find you.
- Bring sunscreen. The sun is very strong at the resort.
- BEWARE OF POISON OAK.
- Dungeon Items: bring your toys. We supply lube, condoms, gloves, paper towels, alcohol, bleach, etc.
- For country & western dancing, bring your cowboy boots.
- Bikers: If you need help transporting your gear, contact Ken Thomas or Tim Pursell at 415 504 8150 to arrange drop off at their apartment. It will be taken to Saratoga Springs by truck and will be available when you arrive at the resort. Upon completion of the weekend, your gear will be transported back to the Eagle Tavern for pickup on Sunday, August 22, between 4pm and 6pm. You will need to be present during that time to collect your gear. Please label your luggage and other items with your name.
- Registration begins at 4pm on Thursday afternoon and dinner will be served at about 7:30pm. If you are going to arrive early you may want to stop in Ukiah or a diner in Upper Lake for lunch. Lunch will not be provided on Thursday.
- Check out is after breakfast on Sunday. Everyone must be out by 12:00 sharp!

Rules

- No pets.
- Smoking is permitted in the smoking gazebo and the pool area only.
- No fires. Not even candles or tiki-torches.
- No glass in the pool or hot tub areas.
- No non-prescription recreational drugs. This is not a place for “chrissy”, “tina” or “PnP”. Leave it at home.
- Parking is designated in the large field at the entrance to the resort. After you unload your gear, immediately move your vehicle to this area. You may NOT park near the lodge, cabins or rear area. Exceptions: Motorcycles may be parked near the lodge, in addition to a few pre-designated vehicles required for emergencies and standard operations.
- You will be issued a name badge when you check in. You are required to carry it on you at all times...No exceptions.
- A lot of LLWers never go into the dungeon. If you use the dungeon space, please review the dungeon rules before playing. The main dungeon tent will be monitored by a dungeon monitor who has the final say on all decision about safety in the dungeon.
- If you take pictures, make sure that no one being photographed objects to having their picture taken ESPECIALLY if you think you might share the picture with friends, co-workers or online. DO NOT TAKE PICTURES OF ANYONE WITH A BRIGHTLY COLORED BADGE.
- If you do not show up for your volunteer shift, you will be required to make arrangements for an alternate shift or we will charge you an additional \$50 after the event has concluded.
